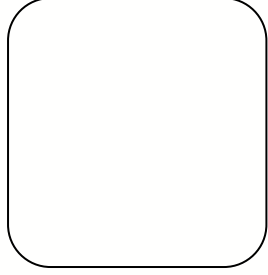
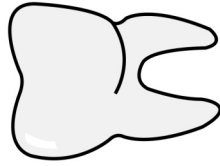
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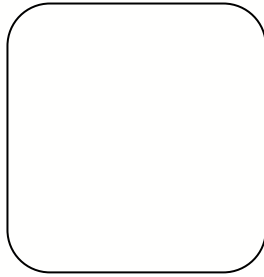
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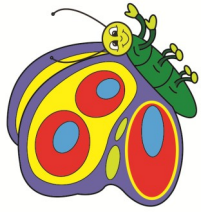
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









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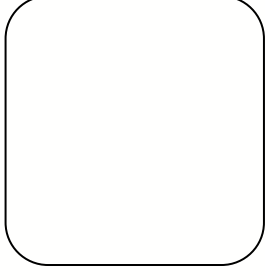


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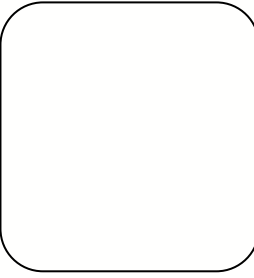


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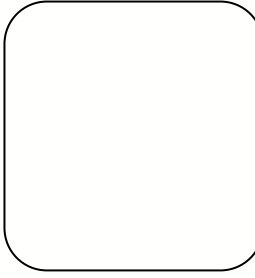
	
	
	
	
	



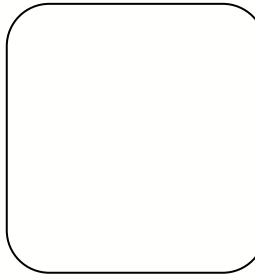
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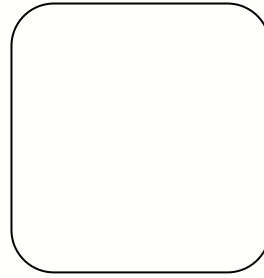
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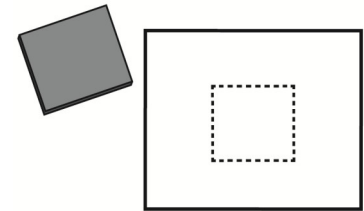
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### **You Will Need:**

- Cookie Sheets (you may wish to paint the cookie sheets, but it is not necessary). The cookie sheets in this activity were purchased at Walmart (Mainstays— Small Cookie Sheet for .88)
- Magnets for the letters (magnetic strips can be found in the craft section of Walmart or other similar stores). Another option is to purchase magnetic business card backing in bulk and cut into squares.
