

Monster Addition

This activity is designed to be used with the foam Alien crafts project found at Hobby Lobby. Please check out the Make, Take & Teach blog for a photo of this project. To assemble the activity, print the oval addition facts on full sheet Avery labels. Cut out the ovals and adhere a label on each foam alien. Decorate the alien as seen on the package. Using a black Sharpie marker, write the correct answer to the fact on the back side of the alien.

There are several games you can play with the monsters. Game 1: Place all monsters on the table. Have the students take turns choosing an monster and solving the addition problem. If correct the player can keep the monster. The player with the most monsters at the end of the game wins. Game 2: Place all monsters on the table. Have the players take turns finding two addition facts with the same sums (4+1, 3+2). If correct the player can keep the monsters.

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Cut above label and adhere to a container to store the monsters.
