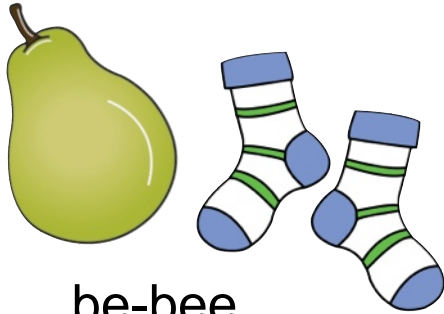

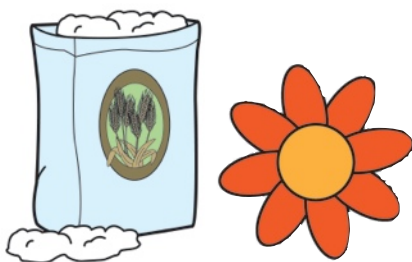
A homophone is a word that sounds the same as another word or words, but has a different meaning and spelling.
