Directions



Provide each student with approximately 10 chips of the same color. Students take turns saying the word and changing the word into the past tense form (e.g. “jump”- “jumped) and placing a chip in the square. You may wish to have your students then put the word into a sentence (“The boy jumped)”. The first student to get 4 of their colored chips in a row either horizontally, vertically or diagonally wins the game. Players must be careful block their opponent while trying to get their own 4-In-A-Row.
